Peace through health A concept about how peace and health is connected, how peace can lead to health, but also how health interventions may contribute to peace and what role peace workers have in peacebuilding.



The Peace through Health training is held by **Dr. Caecilie Buhmann**, physician from Copenhagen specialising in psychiatry and doing her Ph.D. on Post Traumatic Stress Disorder. Dr Buhmann holds a Diploma in Humanitarian Assistance from Fordham University in New York, a BSc in Global Health from University College London and a Master of Public Health from London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine. Dr Buhmann is the IPPNW, International Physicians for the Prevention of Nuclear War, regional vice president of Europe and has experiences from disarmament work with students in India, Pakistan, USA, Russia, China and around Europe.



The Peace through Health training is for medical students from Sweden, Norway, Denmark and Finland.
